

Privacy Policy

Protecting your private information is our priority. This Statement of Privacy applies to www.canzion-films.com and Camrielle Productions, LLC and governs data collection and usage.

For the purposes of this Privacy Policy, unless otherwise noted, all references to Camrielle Productions, LLC include www.canzion-films.com, Canzion Films, Canzion Films and www.canzion-films.com. The Canzion Films website is a news and information site. By using the Canzion Films website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

Collection of your Personal Information

Canzion Films may collect personally identifiable information, such as your:

- Name
- Address
- E-mail Address
- Phone Number

Canzion Films may also collect anonymous demographic information, which is not unique to you, such as your:

- Age
- Gender
- Religion

We may gather additional personal or non-personal information in the future.

Canzion Films encourages you to review the privacy statements of websites you choose to link to from Canzion Films so that you can understand how those websites collect, use and share your information. Canzion Films is not responsible for the privacy statements or other content on websites outside of the Canzion Films website.

Use of your Personal Information

Canzion Films collects and uses your personal information to operate its website(s) and deliver the services you have requested.

Canzion Films may also use your personally identifiable information to inform you of other products or services available from Canzion Films and its affiliates. Canzion Films may also contact you via surveys to conduct research about your opinion of current services or of potential new services that may be offered.

Canzion Films does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties.

Canzion Films may share data with trusted partners to help perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to Canzion Films, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.

Canzion Films may keep track of the websites and pages our users visit within Canzion Films, in order to determine what Canzion Films services are the most popular. This data is used to deliver customized content and advertising within Canzion Films to customers whose behavior indicates that they are interested in a particular subject area.

Canzion Films will disclose your personal information, without notice, only if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on Canzion Films or the site; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of Canzion Films; and, (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of Canzion Films, or the public.

Automatically Collected Information

Information about your computer hardware and software may be automatically collected by Canzion Films. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring website addresses. This information is used for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the Canzion Films website.

Use of Cookies

The Canzion Films website may use "cookies" to help you personalize your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the Web server that you have returned to a specific page. For example, if you personalize Canzion Films pages, or register with Canzion Films site or services, a cookie helps Canzion Films to recall your specific information on subsequent visits.
